Just Add Water

Natural History Museum (Downtown) 5:30-8:30pm

The Natural History Museum hosts an opening reception for *Just Add Water*, a series of large-scale watercolor works by Los Angeles artist Rob Reynolds, inspired by the L.A. Aqueduct that first brought water to the region. The evening includes remarks by the artist and curator. The Museum offers free admission on November 5 and 6, and each visitor receives a bottle of water commemorating the 100 year anniversary of the L.A. Aqueduct. Also in conjunction with this commemoration, The Center for Land Use Interpretation hosts the *There it is. Take It. Bus Trip*, also on Tuesday, November 5. Attendees to be driven to the Cascades, near Sylmar, to witness the reenactment and commemoration of the opening of the Los Angeles Aqueduct at that location, 100 years ago.
